I am pleased to announce that the Towns of Hebron and Bridgewater Newfound Pathway application for the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) monies in Grant Round # 25 has made it through the first step of the process and that the state of New Hampshire has finally received its LWCF Certificate of Apportionment from the National Park Service. The funding available for the Newfound Pathway project is \$100,000.00.

This project still cannot begin until additional components that make up the packet are submitted to the National Parks Service and the project is awarded approval. This office will put together the required components with information from your project application. In some cases there will be more information we require and we will be asking your project contact person for that.


Enclosed you will find two copies of the Project Agreement and the Statement of Assurances. It is important that you and your project coordinator understand and are in agreement with these documents. Please sign both sets where indicated, and return all copies to this office. Upon official notification of your project approval by the National Park Service one set of fully executed documents with Project Number assignment will be returned to you to serve as your authorization to commence your project. The next step will be to obtain a property appraisal to Uniform Appraisal Standards for any Federal Land Acquisitions if needed for your project.

I am also enclosing at this time a Federal Form DI-2010: "Certifications Regarding Debarment, Suspension and Other Responsibility Matters, Drug Free Workplace Requirements and Lobbying. Please check **Part A** and **Part C**, complete **Part C:B** "Place of Performance" (project location), sign (after **Part E**) and type name, title and date, then return with above mentioned documents.

I extend my congratulations to the Towns of Hebron and Bridgewater for an exceptional project proposal. New Hampshire will be richer for your efforts!
